Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Assembly of the International Seabed Authority is invited to note that Reinaldo Storani (Brazil) passed away on 2 May 2021. He had been elected by the Assembly at its twenty-second session as a member of the Committee for a term of five years beginning on 1 January 2017.¹ The terms of office of the current members of the Committee have been extended until 31 December 2022, in line with the decision thereon adopted by the Assembly.²

2. Section 9, paragraph 5, of the annex to the Agreement relating to the Implementation of Part XI of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea of 10 December 1982 provides that, in the event of the death, incapacity or resignation of a member of the Committee prior to the expiration of the term of office, the Assembly shall elect for the remainder of the term a member from the same geographical region or group of States.

3. By a note verbale dated 2 December 2021, the Permanent Mission of Brazil to the International Seabed Authority informed the secretariat of the Authority of the nomination of Thiago Poggio Pádua to fill the seat on the Committee left vacant by Mr. Storani for the remainder of his term ending on 31 December 2022. The curriculum vitae of Mr. Pádua is contained in the annex to the present note.³
